- Shortness of breath on lying flat (orthopnea):
- Waking up breathless
- Ankle swelling *
- Palpitations: 'Are you aware of your heart beating?'
- Cough *
- Sputum
- Blood in sputum *
- Black-outs (syncope)
- Smoking *

Gastrointestinal System

- Mouth ulcers
- Nausea
- Vomiting
- Difficulty in swallowing (dysphagia)
- Indigestion
- Abdominal pain
- Bowel habit *
- Jaundice

Genitourinary System

- Dysuria
- Loin pain
